**Miniatures in Minutes**

**13 Square Foundation:** Amish Scrap

**Finished Foundation:** 6 1/2" by 6 1/2"

**Finished Quilt:** 11" by 11"

**Fabric Requirements:**

Assorted solid colors – scraps (I used 29 different fabrics)

Black (foundation and border) – 1/4 yard

Inner Border – 1/8 yard or scraps

Binding – 1/8 yard

Backing – 1 fat quarter

**Cutting Directions:** Patch size – 1" by 1"

NOTE: Cutting directions are exact. I suggest adding a half-inch or so to allow for minor cutting adjustments.

Colored scraps: a total of 84 patches 1" by 1" (I cut 3 squares each of 29 different fabrics which gave me a few more patches than I needed)

Black: Cut strips 1" by a total of 85" – crosscut into 85 patches

*Inner Border:* (see note about border measurements below)

Cut 2 strips 3/4" by 7"

Cut 2 strips 3/4" by 7 1/2"

*Outer Border:* (see note about border measurements below)

Cut 2 strips 2 1/4" by 7 1/2"

Cut 2 strips 2 1/4" by 11"

*About those border measurements:* The measurements given above are exact – but I don't actually use exact measurements when I am adding borders. My inner border strips are cut 1" wide and then trimmed down after sewing (see the Misc page on my website for a pdf file of how I add narrow borders). I always oversize the outer border (I usually cut them 3 inches wide) and then trim down after quilting.

**Quilt Layout Diagram:**

There is not quilt layout diagram necessary for this quilt – simply alternate dark and colored patches.



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
